



Nonresident
Nebraska Income Tax
Tuition Credit Application
for Academic Year 2021-2022

Individuals who reside outside of Nebraska but paid Nebraska individual income tax in 2020, and the spouses and dependents of such individuals are entitled to a tuition credit for the 2021-2022 academic year. The amount of the tuition credit cannot exceed the nonresident portion of an individual's tuition assessments.

To apply for the Nonresident Nebraska Income Tax Tuition Credit, please follow these steps:

- 1. If you paid Nebraska Individual Income Tax for 2020, attach a copy of your 2020 Nebraska Individual Income Tax Return 1040N. Schedules filed with your return are NOT necessary.
- 2. If your parents paid Nebraska Individual Income Tax for 2020 and you were claimed as a dependent by your parents for 2020, attach a copy of your parents' 1) 2020 U.S. Individual Income Tax Return, form 1040 AND 2) 2020 Nebraska Income Tax Return, form 1040N. Schedules filed with the returns are NOT necessary.
